



Atara Sivan is Professor and Head of the Department of Education Studies at Hong Kong Baptist University. She is the President of the *World Leisure Academy* and has been the Editor-in-Chief of *World Leisure Journal* for the past nine years and member of World Leisure Organization (WLO) Board of Directors for more than a decade. Atara publishes extensively on leisure education, youth development and learning environments and learning communities.
